Levels greater than 2.3 ppm are subject to market discount or rejection based on space and crop year limitations.

Infestation:

Wheat containing 2 live insects injurious to grain (including bran bugs) or any other combinations of dead or live insects totaling 5 will be rejected

Millable Quality:

Wheat supplied must be free of residues of ethylene dibromide (EDB), ethylene dichloride (EDC), carbon tetrachloride (CC14). We request dust suppressant oils not be used on wheat supplied to us. Off quality wheat such as: smutty, heat damaged, garlicky, musty, sour, off-odor, treated, sick insect damage kernels, adulterated, and or contaminated, etc. are subject to market discounts or rejection.

Seller guarantees that wheat delivered will pass pure food & drug inspection until unload.

Until unloaded, title remains in name of seller.
