All discounts will be figured after dockage is deducted and before moisture is shrunk

Dockage:

All dockage deducted from gross weight

Vomitoxin (DON): Parts per Million Discount \$/bu

Levels greater than 2.1 ppm are subject to market discount or rejection

Damage:

Damage over 4.0% subject to discount or rejection. Heat damage over .2% will be rejected.

Foreign Material:

\$.01 for fraction 0.8% - 1.0%; \$.02 for each ½% or fraction 1.1% - 2.5%

Insect Damaged Kernels: (IDK)

3 Kernels per 100 grams; anything over will be rejected

Shrunken and Broken Kernels:

\$.02 discount each ½% or fraction 2.0% to 4.0% inclusive; over 4.0% subject to rejection

Falling Number:

Wheat testing less than 250 falling number subject to market discount or rejection

Smut Balls:

1-4 \$.05 per ball; 5-10 \$.10 per ball; Above 10 balls reject

Garlic (per 100 gram sample):

4 – 12 bulbs \$.01 per bulb or fraction; Above 12 bulbs Rejection

Infestation:

Wheat containing 1 live insect or 2 dead insects injurious to grain will be rejected

Oil:

We request that oil dust suppressant treatment not be used on wheat delivered to us. Seller guarantees that wheat supplied will pass FDA inspection until unloaded and is lien-free. Title remains with seller until unloaded.

Milling Quality:

Wheat of other and/or contrasting classes blended into specified wheat is subject to rejection. Wheat containing any residues of ethylene dibromide (EDB), ethylene dichloride (EDC), or carbon tetrachloride (CCl4), will be rejected upon detection. Off quality wheat such as: smutty, heat damage, garlicky, musty, sour, off-odor, treated, sick, insect damage kernels, adulterated, and/or contaminated, etc. are subject to market discounts or rejection.

*Any wheat containing peanut or tree nut residue will be rejected.

Appropriate FDA clean out procedures must have been followed on trailers that have transported animal protein products, or other hazardous materials, prior to delivery of wheat.
